

Thailand Pass Guide

Before applying for Thailand Pass, please have these documents ready:

- 1. Make an image file of your passport.**
- 2. Make an image file of your vaccination certificate, if applicable.**
- 3. Buy the travel insurance at [AXA Thailand](#).**
- 4. Book your hotel via [Agoda.com](#) or provide an address in Thailand.**

Requirements for the Thailand Pass

The entry requirements for Thailand have been relaxed and simplified since May 1, 2022. You can now apply for your Thailand Pass with fewer documents and obtain a Thailand Pass QR entry code faster and easier.

The document requirements are listed below:

Vaccinated Travelers (No Quarantine):

- Your passport profile page
- A certificate of full (2 doses) vaccination or vaccine card
- A medical insurance policy with at least USD\$ 10,000 minimum coverage

* For unvaccinated children below the age of 18 traveling with a vaccinated parent, may apply for the No Quarantine Thailand Pass under their parent's or guardian's Thailand Pass application. Vaccination document or RT PCR test result of the children will not be required. COVID Insurance will still be required even for children.

Unvaccinated Travelers (No Quarantine):

- Your passport profile page
- An RT-PCR test result no more than 72 hours before your departure date
- A medical insurance policy with at least USD\$ 10,000 minimum coverage

* For unvaccinated children between the age of 6 and 18 years old traveling with an unvaccinated parent, may apply for the No Quarantine Thailand Pass under their parent's or guardian's Thailand Pass application. The RT PCR or professional ATK test result will be required as well. Unvaccinated children below 6 years old are exempted from taking the test. COVID Insurance will still be required even for children.

Flight Details

The next step of the process is to book your flight to Thailand. Although it is not required to submit a proof of flight booking, the Thailand Pass system will require the following information about your flight:

Country of Departure

Date of Arrival in Thailand

Flight Number

Estimated Exit Date from Thailand

Hotel Booking or Address in Thailand

The Thailand Pass system does not require travelers to provide a hotel booking as well. However, you will be required to provide an address in Thailand. If you will be staying in a private accommodation you may provide the complete address.

COVID-19 Insurance

Foreigners are required to submit proof of COVID 19 Insurance with minimum medical coverage of 10,000 USD. It is highly recommended to purchase an insurance that has no waiting period such as AXA Thailand. [AXA Thailand](https://www.axa-thailand.com) has a minimum coverage of 20,000 USD which is even greater than the minimum requirement.

1. This is a single trip policy. This Insurance Policy terminates upon departure from Thailand or the above stated expiry date, whichever is earlier
2. Definition of COVID-19 follows criteria from the Ministry of Public Health of Thailand and/or WHO
3. A combined limit of 750,000 THB applies to Outpatient and Inpatient benefits






Step-by-Step Guide for Thailand Pass Application

Step 1: Visit the official Thailand Pass website


You may go to the official website: <https://tp.consular.go.th/>
Once there, you may choose the option of Air Travel or Land Travel.



After that, you will be directed to a page where you can begin your Thailand Pass registration:



When you begin the registration, you will be directed to the entry program which is No Quarantine:



No Quarantine program for fully vaccinated travelers entering any international airport or selected land borders in Thailand or unvaccinated who have RT PCR test results issued within 72 hours before departure to Thailand. Unvaccinated children below 18 years old must be added to their parent's or guardian's application.

Step 2: Details of your Arrival

In this part, you will provide the purpose of travel to Thailand whether for tourism or if you are a returning resident.

You will also provide your country of departure, airport of arrival, flight number, and date of arrival.

Please make sure that you check the correct spelling of your personal information before you proceed to the next step. Also in this part, children under the age of 18 years will be added to the parent or guardian.

Step 4. Upload Proof of Vaccination or RT PCR Test

In this part, you will provide your vaccination information. You will provide the name or brand of your latest vaccination. You will be able to upload a JPG or PNG file of your proof of vaccination.

For faster processing of your Thailand Pass, it is recommended to also upload the QR code of your vaccination document if it is available.

Note: If you are you are not fully vaccinated, you may upload a copy of your RT PCR or professional ATK test result in lieu of a vaccination certificate issued within 72 hours before departure.

Passengers travelling to and entering Thailand have to be vaccinated with the vaccines approved by Thailand or by the World Health Organization (WHO) or other vaccines as allowed by the Ministry of Public Health of Thailand, no less than 14 days prior to their travels.

Step 6: Submit your COVID 19 Insurance

In this part, you will provide the COVID 19 Insurance. You must upload the certificate of insurance. Based on experience, it is recommended to use [AXA Thailand Insurance](#) as it is the best insurance provider and they will issue a one-page document written specifically for your Thailand Pass application.

Medical Insurance / Proof of Medical Treatment Coverage

While staying in Thailand, your insurance must cover COVID-19 related cost as below:

- Proof of medical coverage such as medical insurance, letter of guarantee, financial statement
- Medical expense coverage of 10,000 USD minimum.
- Your insurance policy must be valid for the entire duration of your stay in Thailand.



Step 7: Review the Summary of your Thailand Pass Application

This is the last part of the application process. You will have a summary of your application. Please check all information that you have provided and if everything is correct, you may submit the application.

You will then receive your 6-digit access code which will appear on your screen and it will also be sent to your registered email.



Processing Time of the Thailand Pass

The processing time for the Thailand Pass application is up to 2 hours depending on the Thai Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Department of Disease Control office. There are instances when the registration will take a couple of minutes to a couple of hours. It is recommended to apply for the Thailand pass at least 2 days before your intended departure.



If Thailand Pass status states 'Approved', you can download the file or save it on your mobile phone.



Once you have been approved, you can download your Thailand Pass QR code or you will also receive it through email. For vaccinated travelers and their dependents, may use the Thailand Pass QR code within 3 days after the estimated arrival date in case of flight delays.

Take note that Thailand Pass is not a visa and it is not a permit to stay in Thailand. It is just a permit to enter Thailand during the COVID 19 pandemic.




When arriving in Thailand, please present Thailand Pass QR Code to the immigration and disease control officers. Please note that if you enter Thailand using a PCR or Antigen test result, your test result must remain valid at the time of departure.

Thailand Pass QR Code

Thailand Pass QR code is the permit to enter Thailand during this COVID pandemic. Every traveler both Thai and foreigners will be required to obtain a Thailand Pass QR code before traveling to Thailand.

Here are some useful information to get to know your Thailand Pass QR code:



1. This is the mode of travel to Thailand. You can enter Thailand by AIR or by LAND. In this example, the traveler will enter Thailand via air travel arriving at an international airport.
2. This shows your full name. It is recommended to follow the name stated in your travel document or passport. Make sure that you have the correct spelling of your name. The title name Mr. Mrs. Miss will not matter in case you have made a mistake.
3. This is the QR code which will be scanned by the officer at the airport upon arrival in Thailand. When you scan this QR code it will show the details of the traveler and the details of the vaccination or RT PCR test. See the example below.
4. This is the departure country. This is the first leg of your trip in case you are transiting in a third country. A transit country is not considered a departure country. If you are traveling from the US to Thailand via Japan, for example, the departure country is the USA and not Japan.
5. This is the proposed date of arrival as stated in your application. You may arrive in Thailand on this date or in case of flight cancellation or delays, you may arrive on an earlier or later date.
6. This is the earliest date when you are allowed to enter Thailand in case of flight changes. You are allowed to enter Thailand earlier than your proposed date of

arrival. You can enter within 7 days before the original date of arrival. This is NOT the start date of your visa or permit to stay in Thailand.

7. This is the latest date when you are allowed to enter Thailand in case of flight changes. You are allowed to enter Thailand later than your proposed date of arrival. You can enter within 7 days after the original date of arrival. This is NOT the expiry date of your visa or permit to stay in Thailand. This is NOT the date you are permitted to stay in Thailand.
8. This is the entry program you are qualified for and approved to enter Thailand. In this example, the traveler is allowed to enter under the NO QUARANTINE program. It means that you do not need to do any pre-departure or on-arrival tests. You are not required to undergo mandatory quarantine. After arriving in Thailand under this program, you can immediately pick up your luggage, leave the airport, or travel to any part of Thailand. There is no requirement to stay in a hotel or pre-arranged transportation.

When you arrive in Thailand, you will pass through an entry screening. You will be asked to show the following documents:

1. Passport
2. Thai Visa (*some nationalities are required to have a visa*)
3. Printed Thailand Pass
4. Printed [COVID Insurance certificate](#)
5. Physical copy of your Vaccination Certificate or RT-PCR test result
6. Flight Booking
7. Hotel Booking (*if applicable*)
